Requirements, Rules and Disclaimers:

- Homeowner must be a teacher, educator, tutor, instructor, coach, trainer, professor, guide, guru, champion, counselor or mentor,
- Homeowner must own a house that needs a new roof in Sheridan County.
- Applicant must be a permanent Sheridan County resident for the past three (3) years.
- Applicants cannot work or be related to any employees or contractor to any of the sponsoring companies.
- Applicant must contribute to the project in some way without being on the roof (i.e., pick up debris, provide refreshments or food to crews, etc.).
- Only one application per person per event.
- Property must be within Sheridan County.
- Property must be structurally sound and show no signs of rot or other forms of decay that would incur remediation.
- The roof must not be a flat roof (must be able to use shingles).
- Property must be free from asbestos and lead and a stick built property.
- Property must have reasonable access for large debris container and material deliveries.
- Qualified applicant property will be required to have a clear title report.
- Property cannot be in default.
- Property must be the applicant's primary residence and continue to be the primary residence for one year from the substantial completion date.
- By submitting or approving the application, the applicant agrees to allow Wyoming Roofing, Owen's Corning, Knecht Home Center and Big Horn Mountain Radio Network to use information given in nomination at their discretion on their websites and through other media outlets.
